- higher household usage
- **Urbanization**
- Economic development / water & energy demand

- changing diet patterns
- Number of people living in countries chronically short of water:
- 2000: half a billion (out of six billion)
- 2050: four billion (out of nine billion)

Main issues

"In getting our waters clean, the role of citizens and citizens' groups will be crucial" (EC, 2010).

- appropriate measures involve balancing the interests of various groups <> open to the scrutiny of those who will be affected
- Enforceability requires transparency

Main problems:

- core competence of policy-making bodies
- limited consultation with / participation of primary stakeholders and major groups

additional problems:

- seen as target group / beneficiary not as actors
- access to information <> informed choices (Aarhus / Rio)
- language




