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RiBaSE Interoperability Experiment



In the standardisation approach, an **Interoperability Pilot** is being run that integrates several **standard formats and web services** in a flood scenario for three case studies: Scheldt, Maritsa and Severn. The **River Basin Standards Interoperability Pilot (RiBaSE)** is being held under the OGC supervision and with a panel of experts involved, including **ict4water** cluster members: WIDEST (EURECAT) & FREEWAT (SUSPI).

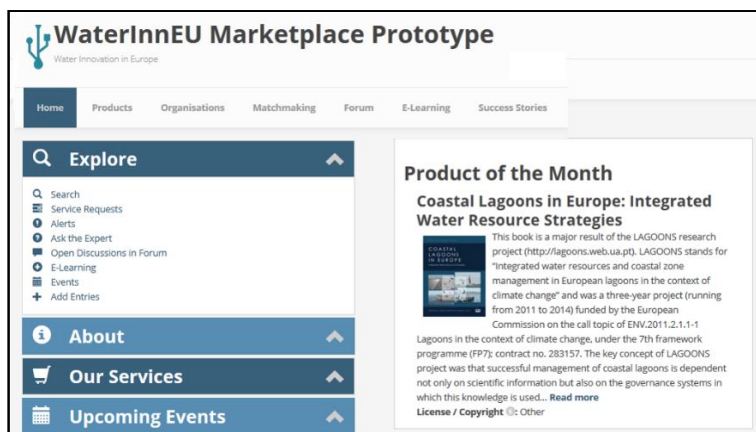

Selection of the offerings of the marketplace

The relevant **EU funded projects** with new categorized information and the projects and **candidate companies** able to work with have been collected in two databases. More than a **hundred stakeholders and end-users** had been surveyed to know their priorities and to select the more interesting products for them. These products have been described in standard **Product Specification Sheets (PSS)**.



WaterInnEU Marketplace prototype

The prototype version of the **WaterInnEU virtual Marketplace** has been launched. The platform provides **innovative products** with documentation about them and **contacts to experts** for the water resources management. In addition, an **inventory of projects and organisations** is available.
