Previously he worked as an environmental consultant and held various management positions from 1983-2003 with WL | Delft Hydraulics (now Deltares) and the Dutch Ministry of Environment.



The Regional Water Authority De Dommel is responsible for surface-water management, flood control, sanitation, irrigation and drainage, and services about one million inhabitants in the greater Eindhoven area.

Peter Glas serves on the executive board of the Dutch Association of Regional Water Authorities since 2005 and was elected president in 2010. Currently he is in his second term of three years. In this capacity he represents 10.000 employees of 24 Regional Water Authorities with an annual turnover of €2,5 billion.

As a reserve colonel he is member of the advisory staff for civil-military operations of the Commander of the Royal Netherlands Army.

Peter Glas is frequently invited to chair seminars and gives speeches on topics related to climate change and water management.
