




Host: ADB HQ, National Water Resources Board (NWRB) and Laguna Lake Development Authority (LLDA)



Participants: Attended by 30 delegates from 7 countries

Participants: 14 delegates from 6 countries






Sustainable management for Water Resources Infrastructures (5)

Indonesia



Host: Jasa Tirta I Public Corporation
