



## ***Call for posters***

Europe-INBO 2018 workshop on

“Invasive Alien Species: how to develop solutions for preventing and managing their introduction and spread?

What connections with WFD implementation and RBMP preparation? ”

- **Posters**

The contents of the poster shall not be too scientific nor technically focused as the INBO's audience is made of a variety of profiles, such as river basin policy makers and managers.

Proposals for posters are invited by email to [ias@riob.org](mailto:ias@riob.org) within the themes below:

- IAS management measures (linked to the aquatic environment);
- Innovative detection methods for IAS;
- Example of communication tools.

The poster discussion will take place on October 17<sup>th</sup>, between noon and 1:30 pm.

- **Deadline for submission**

Deadline: latest 15<sup>th</sup> September 2018 latest (NOTE: if poster abstracts are submitted earlier we may be able to already in some cases confirm acceptance)

- **Format**

Poster boards are in **portrait format** (the final poster may not exceed the A0 standard (841 x 1189 mm)).

Prefer in font or type of character: ARIAL or HELVETICA

The TITLE must be legible at 5 meters, and the content must be legible at 1 to 2 meters

You will have to print your poster by your own.

- **Oral summaries of posters**

Authors of poster papers should be prepared to provide ad hoc a summary of their poster presentation (1–2 slides) during the corresponding oral session in case an opportunity should occur in the time schedule or if the convener has foreseen the presentation of poster summaries during the oral session.

- **Submission**

**To candidate a poster, please send by email ([ias@riob.org](mailto:ias@riob.org)) a 1- page WORD or PDF document including (in this order, in English):**

- Proposed title – max 15 words

- Key words - max 5 words

- Summary of poster content – max 250 words

- Name, job title/position, organisation, country and email (obligatory) for lead presenter and also this same information for all co-authors (name of lead author should be underlined)

- OPTIONAL: short list of key reference publications, websites or other sources of background and supplementary information.
