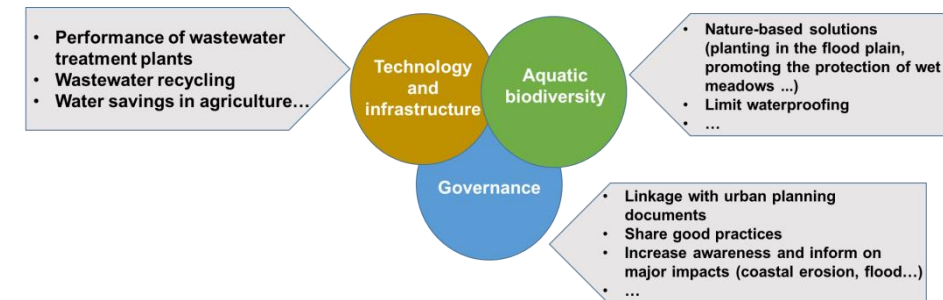
- **Commitment** of water agencies at the end of 2018: 20 projects incubated over 5 years (2018-2022)
- **Themes** : improving knowledge / climate change adaptation strategy / "green infrastructure" projects / governance

Why do water agencies get involved?

- Important public entity of **french water policy**
- Involvement regarding **international cooperation** for access to water and sanitation services
- About 20 **institutional partnership** with water foreign authorities



- ➔ Involvement in a collective dynamics with strategic goal
- ➔ Experience-sharing : **climate change adaptation plans** in each of the 6 french basins (COP 21 - 2015)



Water agency involvement : 13 incubations



- **50 000 €** per project
- In the context of **institutional partnerships** between french water agencies and foreign authorities (basin agency, water ministry, cross-border body, municipalities, NGO's...)
- **International office for water** as technical operator
- **13 incubated projects** :

2 in Benin	5 municipalities of coastal lagoons (Mono downstream)
	Lower and middle valley of the Oueme basin

Example : utilizing sanitation by-product into natural fertiliser (Burkina Faso)

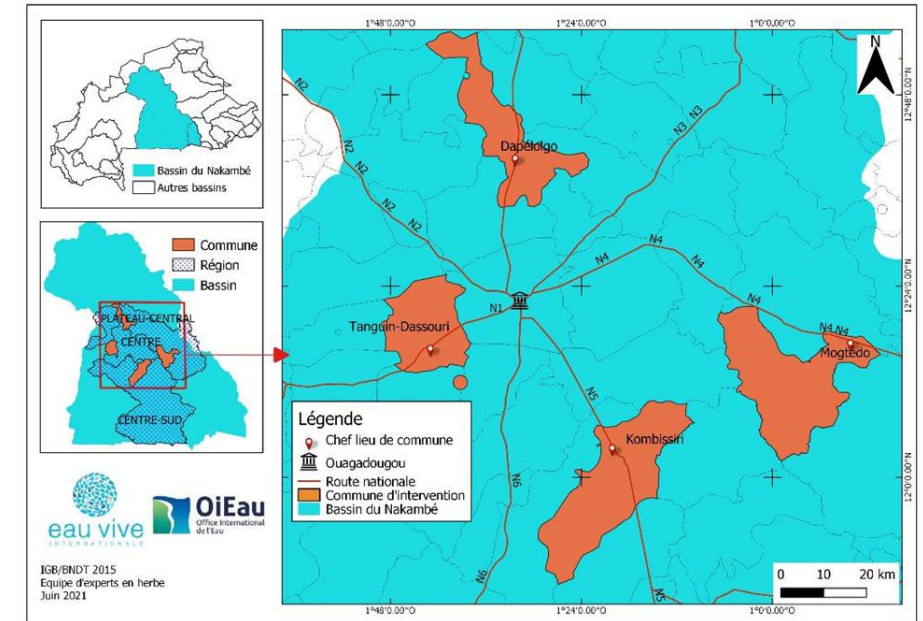
Historical partnership with Nakanbe basin agency (since 2010)

Existing projects from which possibility to capitalise : « agro-ecological » latrin experiences funding by Loire-Bretagne and Rhône-Méditerranée-Corse water agencies)

Goals : health improvement / food safety based on agro-ecological model / combating of soil erosion and desertification

Intermediate results :

→ **4 selected municipalities** (population acceptability, agricultural land, production type...)

→ Create infrastructure / ensuring farmers against soil erosion / operation follow-up : estimated cost of **4,7 millions EUR**

→ **Potential funders** : Adaptation fund, development french agency, african development bank...
