Project objective



Support multi-level and cross-sectoral water governance for a transition to sustainable water systems



By developing a set of digital **tools and services** embedded in a single **platform**



Tools and methods will be tested and co-developed in 5 Pilot Sites.

Relying on several approaches

Social innovation: combining technological and nontechnological dimensions (governance, capacity building, economics) of innovative products, process or services.

Multi-level: involving stakeholders from different scales (local, regional, national...)

Cross sectoral: considering a wider focus than only water - including food, energy, ecosystem, health

Context



• **Key challenges** in the 21st century: Climate change impact, maintaining the access to water (both in quality and quantity)...

- The emergence of these societal challenges has increased the importance of finding solutions which can **reconcile both**
 - economic growth and social outcomes on one hand,
 - their **technological**, **capacity building**, **governance** and **economic** dimensions on the other hand.

This is where **social innovation** comes into place.

Social innovation - Definition



- Social innovation: design & implementation of innovative solutions which ultimately aim to improve the welfare and wellbeing of individuals and communities.
- It means tackling societal, water-related challenges by combining the **technological & non-technological** dimensions (governance, capacity building and economic) of innovation.




- New combinations (or hybrids of existing and new) of products, processes and services.
- Aim: to involve the stakeholders (final users) and give them a clear role to codevelop and experience governance solutions that they will use in an autonomous manner in the end



A collaborative approach



- Social innovation also implies new patterns of **stakeholders' involvement** and learning fully aligned with the **innovative** and **cross sector** governance challenges.
- A **complementary approach** to technological innovation, with the potential to address the complex, societal and environmental challenges by encouraging:
 - > novel approaches, collaboration and cross-sector partnerships
 - > from all stakeholders including local communities, as well as from different expertise and skills.



The WEFE+H Nexus.



Social Innovation in InnWater



InnWater's approach is embedded in social innovation. The project will:

- Develop a digital platform (technological dimension), composed of different tools
- Develop a series of capacity development activities, to ensure these tools are used by stakeholders
- ❖ The governance dimension refers to the feedbacks and recommendations that will be delivered from the PS & tools like water governance assessment
- The economic dimension envisages the sustainability of InnWater solutions through an exploitation plan
