



## Mab Unesco Program since 1971
























# **Main Challenges**

- Political boundaries provincial, regional
- Funding Opportunities for projects and for personnel
- Logistics not always easy to dialogue with people who you don't work with daily and are in different locations
- have a multidisciplinary approach to water resource management and use different languages according to the stakeholders engaged











### **Lessons Learnt**

- the territory calls for coordination to help bring local actors into dialogue with higher authorities on common issues such as resource management
- Biosphere Reserves represent a useful common working table to create this dialogue
- The proper implementation of projects can lead to greater stability and continuity in the future
- Important to include local stakeholders in the planning of projects – they know the area best! (although often easier said than done)
