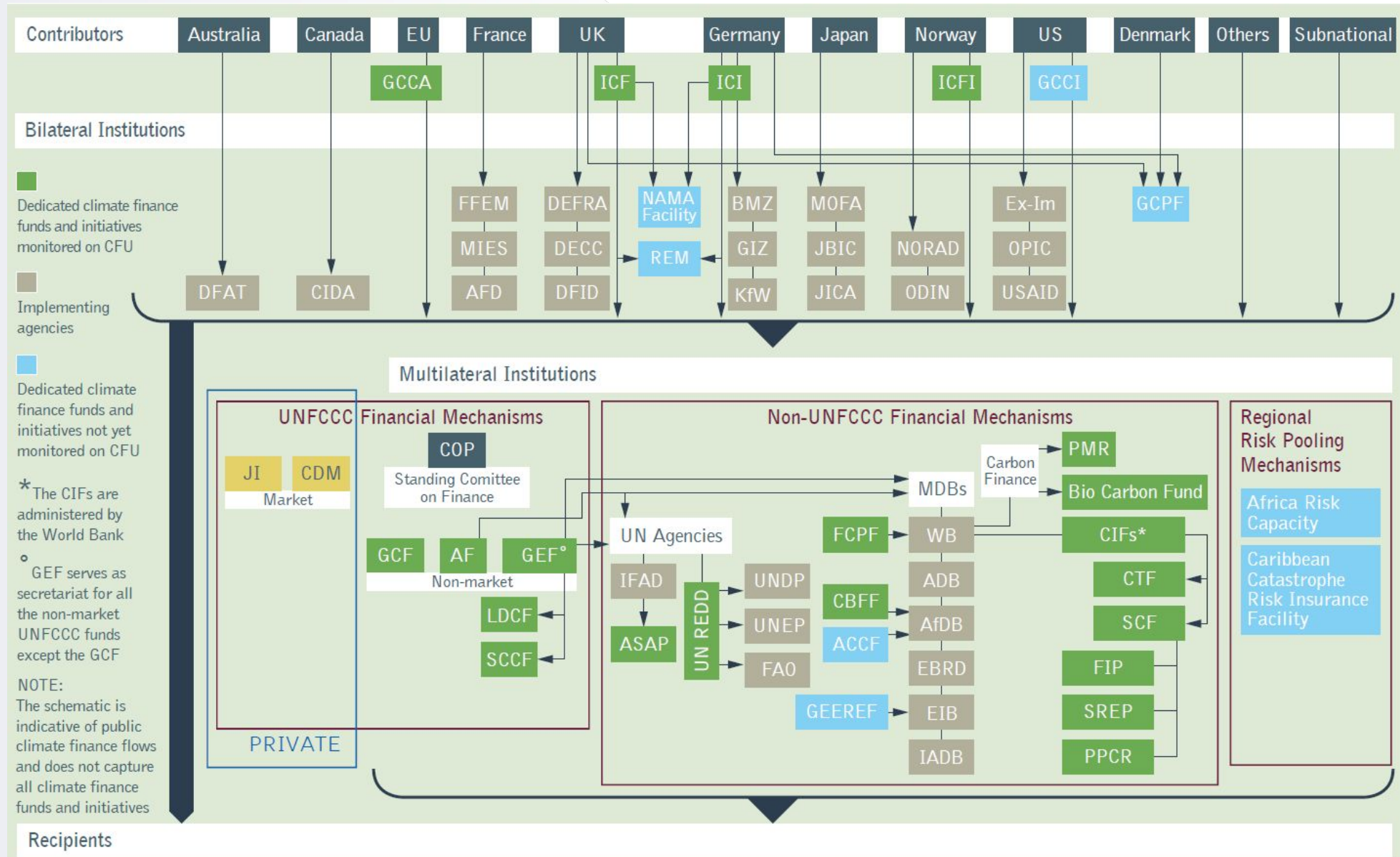


Global climate finance architecture: volume is not an issue! But complexity in access is...

- **Objective:** To accelerate project development and facilitate access to climate finance.
- **Activity:** providing technical support for the first steps of development of projects of adaptation to climate change at the level of the basins of rivers, lakes and associated aquifers.
- **Means:** modest grants for microprojects on:
 - Capacity building and knowledge
 - Improving governance
 - Planning basin adaptation to climate change
 - Setting-up sustainable financial mechanisms for basin adaptation plans
- **Leverage:** from 1 to 100 (average budget for incubation: 60.000 USD ; average budget of project implementation: 6.000.000 USD)



The Lake Victoria Basin Commission (LVBC)

- LVBC is a specialized institution of the East African Community (EAC) mandated to oversee sustainable development of Lake Victoria Basin (LVB)
- Establishment of the Commission is provided for under Article 114 of EAC Treaty (1999)
- The operations of the Commission is governed by the Protocol for Sustainable Development of LVB (2003) & the LVBC Act 2022
- Other guiding documents include:
 - the Shared Vision and Framework of EAC,
 - LVBC Strategic Plan 2021/2026, derived from the EAC Development Strategy, and
 - LVB-SECOM & EAC COM Decisions & Directives
- LVB - A Common Regional Economic Growth Zone due to its Huge Environmental Natural Resources

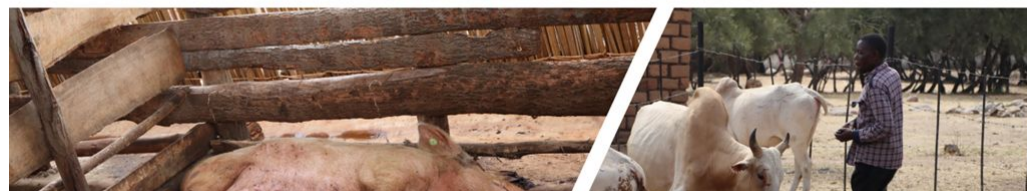
Recent Project Funds accessed through climate finance

1. Adapting to Climate Change in Lake Victoria Basin (ACC-LVB) project: Grant **USD 5 Million** from the Adaptation Fund
2. Climate Resilience for Sustainable Maritime Transport Infrastructure in the Lake Victoria Basin (CRESTI-LVB) project - Grant of **USD 9.15 Million** under the Adaptation sub-window of the African Development Bank Climate Action Window (AfDB-CAW)
3. Preparatory funding for CRESTI-LVB project - grant of **USD 260K** under the Technical Assistance sub-window of the AfDB – CAW
4. Lake Victoria Basin Transboundary Agricultural Water – Food Nexus Investment Program (TWAIP – LVB) - AfDB KOREA-African Economic Cooperation (KOAPEC) Trust Fund **USD 875K**

Total: Grant **USD 15.29 Million**



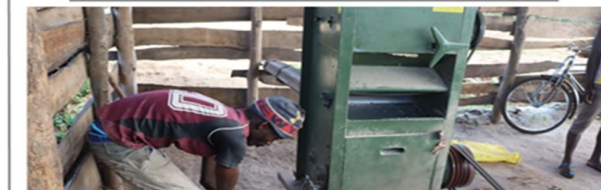
